WHO IS QUALIFIED TO JOIN?

Any Marine or Navy FMF Corpsmen currently on active duty or have served Honorably for not less than ninety (90) days and have earned the Eagle, Globe and Anchor or are serving or have served in the Marine reserve and earned 90 reserve retirement credit points or have served as a FMF Navy Corpsmen and trained with FMF units for not less than ninety (90) days and earned the Marine Corps Device (clasp). Discharged members must have served Honorably. A General discharge under Honorable conditions is acceptable. Character of service will be defined by the DD-214 as stated.
