# **PURPOSE - MISSION-ELIGIBILITY**

PURPOSE: The purpose of the Hershel Woody Williams Scholarship program is to assist and encourage eligible applicants to further their academic Education and/or training by offering the opportunity to advance their goals in life.

The Hershel Woody Williams Scholarship Program is incorporated in the West Virginia Department of the Marine Corps League and is governed by the Department Board of Trustees consisting of Department Commandant,

Department Senior Vice Commandant, Jr. Vice Commandant, Department Judge Advocate with a (3) three member Committee including a Chair Person appointed by the Board of Trustees to administer the scholarship program under the Department of West Virginia Marine Corps League By-Laws.

MISSION: To provide scholarships upon application, to eligible relatives of those Marines who are lost in the line of duty in the Marine Corps and to eligible relatives of active members of the Department of West Virginia Marine Corps League.

ELIGIBILITY: Those eligible to apply for a scholarship are: wife/husband, children, grandchildren, stepchildren, adopted children of a Department of West Virginia Marine Corps League member or Auxiliary member. Each applicant is eligible for only (1) one Scholarship. Applicants not awarded may reapply. Scholarships are available for Educational goals in Universities, colleges, Trade Schools or Specialty Schools for which there is a tuition or fee cost. If the applicant fails to enroll in the year of award, the funds must be returned from the proposed school to the Scholarship Committee Chair. Applications must be complete and received by March 15<sup>th</sup> of the year. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.

## **AUTHORITY**

APPLICATION DEADLINE;: MARCH 15TH EACH YEAR.

All applicants will be notified of the Scholarship Committee's decision no later than April 30<sup>th</sup> of the award year.

Scholarship awards are awarded for spring or summer semesters or current period of enrollment for the current year.

Scholarship awards checks will be sent to the institution the applicant is to attend. In the event the applicant fails to enter as scheduled, the scholarship award will be returned to the Scholarship Chair.

Within 30 days of the applicant entering the first term the applicant will notify the Scholarship Chair of their enrollment.

### REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must follow these requirements in order for the scholarship award to be accepted:

- (a) Complete and sign the application
- (b) Submit required supporting documents
- (c) Obtain the Signature of the Detachment Commandant or Adjutant
- (d) Provide a letter of recommendation from the following:
  - 1. For High School.....School Administrator
  - 2.For University or College......Counselor or Advisor
- (e) Letter of Acceptance by the Institution planning to attend
- (f) A brief history of prior achievements in school or life.
